The PSA and SPSF (SA Branch) Councils met on Monday 17 September. Highlights from the meetings included:

HEALTH ISSUES

Council received reports on issues affecting members in Health. These included details of the South Australian Metropolitan Hospital Efficiency and performance Review of all major metropolitan public hospitals, and concerns over Salary Sacrifice arrangements and other issues arising from the proposed move to a Statewide Pathology Service.

PUBLIC PRIVATE PARTNERSHIPS

The General Secretary reported on the Governments proposal to build new prisons and a youth detention centre and concerns that some functions may be outsourced despite prior Government commitments that this would not occur.

APPOINTMENT
