

PSA AND SPSF (SA BRANCH) APRIL COUNCIL MEETING

Key issues considered by the meetings included:

PRIME MINISTER RUDD FORUM

The President reported on PSA attendance at Prime Minister Rudd's Jobs Forum held at Mawson Lakes on 20 April, where the Prime Minister placed great emphasis on job creation to stimulate the economy.

PUBLIC SECTOR BILL

The Chief Industrial Officer advised that the Public Sector Bill debate was listed to continue in the Legislative Council on the resumption of Parliament on the 28th of April.

ENTERPRISE BARGAINING

The Chief Industrial Officer reported that members had provided significant feedback on matters to be addressed in negotiations for a new Parity Enterprise Agreement. The current agreement concludes in December this year, and under the terms of that Agreement, a new claim can be lodged in September.

The Acting General Secretary advised Council that the May Day March and family picnic will commence at 10 am on Saturday, 2nd May from Victoria Square.
