ENTERPRISE BARGAINING BALLOT

Council acknowledged the overwhelming Yes vote of 92% of votes cast in support of the PSA position and placed on record the work of the General Secretary, Assistant General Secretary and staff in securing such a high vote.

PSA HOLIDAY HOMES

A proposal to redevelop the site of the Robe Holiday Homes, involving a significant upgrade to the level of accommodation, was approved.

WORKCHOICES

Council noted the high level of involvement of PSA members in the National Day of Union and Community Action and members' continuing involvement in the WorkChoices campaign.

NON-INDUSTRIAL BENEFITS
