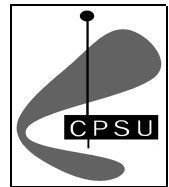

## **HEALTH BUDGET 2009/2010**

The South Australian State Budget for 2009/10 was delivered yesterday 4 June 2009.

Further to the general Brief issued by the PSA, this report deals with Agency specific matters.

The total operating expenditure budget for the health portfolio in 2009/10 is \$4036 billion.

This years Budget included funding for the following initiatives.

- \$61.7 million over four years for the implementation of a service reform model for emergency departments which provides integrated and coordinated interdisciplinary care combined with inpatient flow and capacity management.
- \$40 million over four years associated with increasing the amount of sub acute ambulatory activity relating to rehabilitation, geriatric and evaluation management and palliative care services.

The 2009/10 capital program includes:

- \$85 million to continue the redevelopments at
  - \* Flinders Medical Centre
  - \* Lyell McEwin Hospital
  - \* The Queen Elizabeth Hospital
- \$30 million towards the construction of the \$200 million SA Health and Medical Research Institute.
- \$34 million for the construction of Marion GP plus Health Care Centre, and the running of Elizabeth GP plus Health Care Centre.
