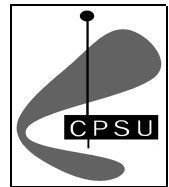

HEALTH BUDGET 2009/2010

The South Australian State Budget was delivered on Thursday 4 June 2009. This years total operating expenditure budget for Country Health SA in 2009/10 is \$630.4 million, to be spent on public hospitals and health services.

Further to the general Brief issued by the PSA, this report deals with Agency specific matters.

This years budget also included funding for the following key Capital Works Projects:

- \$360,000 for the construction of the Port Pirie GP Plus Health Care Centre
- \$1.6Million to upgrade Hammill House at Port Pirie Hospital
- \$15.6Million for the redevelopment of Ceduna Hospital
- \$7.million for the development of Whyalla Hospital
- \$5.7million to commence the development of the Berri Hospital
- \$900,000 for the provision of new intermediate care mental health facilities within Country Intermediate Care Facilities
- 2.1million to replace two Breast Screen SA country mobile units
