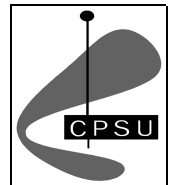

MAGILL AND CAVAN YOUTH TRAINING CENTRES

BUDGET 2009/10 - NO NEW CENTRE

Public Service Association President, Lindsay Oxlad and Chief Industrial Officer Peter Christopher attended the Budget lock-up. The State Budget for 2009-10 was handed down on the afternoon of June 4th by The Treasurer, the Hon Kevin Foley.

The most significant news to come from the Budget, is the announcement that there will no new Secure Care facility. The Government has withdrawn from the Public Private Partnership to build the new Youth Training Centre at Cavan.

This raises serious concern for the safety and welfare of members working at Magill and Cavan. Assurances by the department that members safety concerns will be addressed with the construction and commission of a new centre are now in jeopardy.

An urgent meeting with the Chief Executive of the Department for Families and Communities and the Executive Director of Families SA will be called by the PSA.

The next PSA Secure Care Worksite Representative meeting will be held at Magill on the 12th of June 2009.
