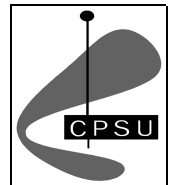

TO ALL PSA MEMBERS IN HOUSING SA

BUDGET IMPACT - HOUSING SA

The State Treasurer, the Hon Kevin Foley MP, today handed down the 2009 - 2010 State Budget.

The general impact has been detailed in a separate Brief to PSA members.

This Brief deals with the implications for Housing SA members and the community, pending a more detailed analysis.

Key issues are:

There are no indications that an increase in staffing numbers will occur.

The announcement that 1500 houses will be built, does little to alleviate the pressures for PSA members or a waiting list of in excess of 22,000.

Regular meetings are occurring with departmental representatives and PSA Worksite Representatives to discuss the implications of the new National Housing Agreement and associated National Partnership.

Feedback from members is invited, particularly with examples of how the changes will affect PSA members or the community.
